California State Parks

The Disabled Discount Pass entitles a person with permanent disabilities its bearer to a 50% discount for use of all basic facilities (including vehicle day use, family camping, and boat use fees) at any unit of the California State Park System operated by the California Department of Parks and Recreation, except Hearst San Simeon SHM.

The Access Pass may be issued to U.S. citizens or permanent residents of any age that have been medically diagnosed with permanent disability. The Access Pass admits pass owner/s and passengers in a non-commercial vehicle at per-vehicle fee areas. (Children under 16 are always admitted free.)
