



Safety Guidelines

Safety is always our first priority!!!! In order to maintain the highest level of safety possible for you and our campers, please note the following safety guidelines:

1. Stay within an arms reach of your camper at all times.
2. If you or your camper gets injured, tell your leader **immediately** so that the appropriate steps can be taken.
3. Always stay with the group. There must be a Leader, Co-Leader or Counselor with you and your camper at all times (going to the bathroom, changing for waterplay, etc.).
4. Follow your leader's instructions at all times.
5. Be on time, dressed appropriately, and ready for a fun filled day of work. If you have any questions or concerns, talk to your leader immediately.
6. Be aware if your camper has allergies or photo restrictions; these will be listed on the camper's daily nametag.
7. Make sure your camper **does not** eat any food he/she did not bring with them to camp that day unless it is provided by a group leader.
8. Always make sure your camper is wearing a helmet when playing on the riding toys. Knee and elbow pads are also encouraged if available.
9. If the moonbounce deflates, **calmly** assist the campers in safely exiting the moonbounce.
10. Please inform your leader of any issues that may arise with your camper so that he/she can inform the child's parent(s). Only the leader is allowed to talk to a child's parent(s). If a parent asks you a question (ie How was their day?), you must refer them to your leader.
